# Travel Safely with Cheswick

Staying safe while walking, biking and riding in the car is important! While walking, use the \_\_\_\_\_ when possible. If no sidewalk is available, always walk on the side of the road facing traffic. The safest place to cross the road is a \_\_\_\_\_. If the driver picks up their \_\_\_\_\_, let them know that you don't feel safe when they use their phone while driving. Remember that kids under 13 are safest in the back seat!
